



Sexual Assault: Providing Core Services

Participation and Registration

The **SEXUAL ASSAULT TRAINING INSTITUTE** of the Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force will be providing training for individuals who provide support and/or advocacy to sexual assault survivors. This 30.5 hour training will provide participants with the information, strategies and skills necessary to provide core sexual assault specific advocacy services.

The Core Services training is not intended for, or open to, other disciplines (medical professionals, law enforcement, etc.). Participants may only register for the training in its entirety – selective registration for particular sessions is not available for this training.

Training Location

The Sexual Assault: Providing Core Services training will be held at the Salem Conference Center. The conference center address is 200 Commercial Street SE, Salem, OR, 97301. On-site, complimentary parking is available in the underground parking garage.
